This has reference to letter Nos. 863-204/79 UGC Unit.II-2 dated 10.8.1987 and No. 2410-204/79 AC/UGC dated 5.12.87 from the Registrar Osmania University for grant of autonomy to the following colleges:

1. University College for Women, Hyderabad.
2. Nizam College, Hyderabad.
3. RBVRR Women's College, Hyderabad.
4. Anwar Ul-Uloom College, Hyderabad.
5. SSRz Cyothi Arts & Science College, Khairatabad.
6. St. Francis College for Women, Secunderabad.

These recommendations have been concurred to by the Secretary, Govt. Education Department, Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. 3688/UE 2/87-1 EDN dated 13.11.87.

2. I am now pleased to convey concurrence of the UGC to the grant of autonomous status to the aforesaid colleges, by the Osmania University. This is subject to the following:-

1. The colleges shall constitute organizational structure on the lines suggested in the UGC Revised Guidelines (1986) on the scheme of autonomous colleges, which may be agreed to by the university:
- ii. the autonomous status may be granted by the university for a period of five years in the first instance and review shall be undertaken by the university after three years as to the performances/functioning of the colleges with the help of the committee as indicated in the UGC guidelines; and ✓
- iii. the colleges shall start functioning as 'autonomous' from the commencement of the academic session 1988-89.

3. Necessary orders granting autonomous status to the colleges be issued by the University under intimation to the
